### Eligibility

**Applicants must be a child of a US veteran.** The contest is open to Wisconsin high school seniors attending public, private, parochial, or home schools. The contest is also open to already enrolled college students. Applicants must be accepted at a college or university for the upcoming academic semester, including but not limited to four-year college/university, two-year college/university, junior college/university, technical college/university, and vocational college/university.. Board Members of Horicon Marsh Veterans Hunt and members of their families are not eligible to participate.

### Application Process

- The contest deadline is August 15<sup>th</sup> 2023
- Applicant must provide college transcript for upcoming semester
- Applicant must provide typed completed application form
- Applicant must submit a typed 1.5 spaced essay of how a veteran or military event has affected their life
- Must be available October 21, 2023 to receive the scholarship in person at the Horicon Marsh Veterans Hunt event

### Winner

There will be one \$1,000 winner of the scholarship. Winner will be announced on or before September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The winner will be made aware with a phone call from a board member of the Horicon Marsh Veterans Hunt. The winner must attend Horicon Marsh Veterans Hunt on October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023 to receive the scholarship. Scholarship presentation will be done around 12 o'clock before the raffle starts.
